NATIONAL swimmer Wong Fu Kang won two gold medals in the swimming competition of the Malaysian Institutions of Higher Learning Games (SUKIPT) yesterday.

Fu Kang took the men's 100m breaststroke and 4x100m medley relay titles with ease at the National Aquatics Centre in Bukit Jalil.

"I am proud to represent Taylor's University and contribute gold medals for them. I want to win six in this competition," he said.

"Although I am a national swimmer, I cannot take things lightly as others are also swimming well.
