

Covid-19 donation drive

UNIVERSITI Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) collected a total of RM24,420 for frontliners battling Covid-19 in a donation drive.

Led by UKM's Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanity, the funds were used for the stitching of 5,000 sets of personal protective equipment (PPE).

Of the 5,000, the varsity said

Hospital Tuanku Ja'afar, Seremban, donated materials for 1,000 PPE while the rest were from a non-governmental organisation.

"We sewed 1,000 pairs of socks for Hospital Tuanku Ja'afar by collaborating with an industrial training and rehabilitation centre," UKM said in a statement.
