• Bachelor degree with honours in areas of relevance from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia with CGPA <2.75 or other universities accredited by the Senate with at least one years experience in areas of relevance

Doctor of Philosophy

• Master in areas of relevance from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia or other universities accredited by the Senate

OR

• Presently following master programme in related field in UKM and approved by the Graduate Management Committee to change the status to Doctor of Philosophy programme with the approval of the UKM Senate's

OR

• Bachelor degree with honours in related field from UKM or any institutions of higher learning accredited by the UKM Senate and acquired CGPA ≥ 3.70
