## **a. Background**

This international conference is the 8<sup>th</sup> series of Islamic Discourse organized annually by the Faculty of Education, University Kebangsaan Malaysia since 2008. This year, the conference is held at the University of Wales Trinity Saint David, Lampeter, United Kingdom. It is jointly organized by The Malaysian Student Department for United Kingdom and EIRE High Commission of Malaysia, Faculty of Education Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) and University of Wales Trinity Saint David Wales.

## **b. Objectives**

The main objectives of this conference are:

- i. To provide a platform for scholars, experts and researchers across nations to discuss and exchange thoughts, knowledge and research findings on matters regarding Islamic knowledge for unity and better understanding.
- ii. To provide opportunities for cross-nation interaction and networking.
- iii. To discuss and analyze the implementation of education policies across nations and its effect on humanity.
