3) PC operation

Please handle the PC on your own during your presentation.

* There will be a laptop computer installed with MS PowerPoint 2013 in each presentation room. * (MS PowerPoint 2010, 2007, 2003 are also available).

Please bring your presentation material saved in a USB memory stick or CD-ROM (please make sure to run virus check before bringing the data) which is readable on Windows 8 or its convertibles. If you will be using your own laptop for the presentation,

please ensure that it is compatible with the D-sub 15pin.

*As a precautionary measure, please also bring a USB memory stick containing your presentation. D-sub 15pin (PC side)

 - 1) PC environment for presentation
