Regulation of the Civil Aviation Board

No. 10

relating to the Qualifications of Applicants for Flight Engineers and Privileges of Licensed Flight Engineers

By virtue of Section 15 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497, the Civil Aviation Committee, with the approval of the Minister of Transport, hereby issues the following Regulation:

Clause 1. Clause 1 of the Regulation of the Civil Aviation Committee No. 4 dated 17 May B.E. 2500 shall be repealed, only in the parts relating to the qualifications of applicants for flight engineers and rights of licensed flight engineers.

Clause 2. An applicant to be a flight engineer shall have the following qualifications;

Age;

Not less than 24 years old.

Knowledge in the following fields;

- a. Fight theory and fundamental aerodynamics.
- b. Fundamental principles of aircraft maintenance, procedures for the maintenance of aircrafts, aircraft engines and equipment installed on aircrafts which shall usually be supervised by a flight engineer.
- c. Minor maintenance, configuration and replacement of aircraft equipment during flight.
- d. Aircraft performance including speed limitations and counter measures in case of engine malfunctions or power losing.
- e. Flight plan determination from information including loading position, center of gravity, characteristics of fuels and engine capability.
- f. Engine power control and meteorological effects.
- g. Air navigation law relevant to the licensed flight engineers.

Experience;

The applicant shall have trained, either in aircraft or flight simulator, have completed not less

than 200 flight hours as a flight engineer. If the applicant is a licensed ground flight engineer, the

applicant shall have completed not less than 50 flight hours as a flight engineer. In case of a pilot, the

applicant shall have operated as a pilot-in-command in aircraft operated by at least 4 engines, not less

than 200 flight hours.

Skill;

The applicant shall have demonstrated the ability to perform as flight engineer of an aircraft

during flight and emergency situations.

Medical fitness;

The applicant shall have medical fitness in compliance with Convention on International

Civil Aviation regarding licensed flight engineers.

Clause 3. The privileges of a licensed flight engineer shall be to act as flight engineer of any type of

aircraft on which the holder has obtained a license, provided that such privileges shall not be usable if the

licensee fails to possess updated information, guidance and manual for such aircraft or has not operated as a

flight engineer for 6 consecutive months.

This Regulation shall take effect from 7 of February B.E. 2506 onwards
