- The structure and approach of scientific research must begin with a defined research question, which results in a well-designed research protocol that plans the overall approach. This foundation should lead to a set of data from which the manuscript can be constructed.
- Total words of manuscript are 6000 to 8000 words in length (single line spacing and 10 pt. size Times New Roman throughout the paper except for the headlines).
- The structures of the manuscript typically have the following components.

Abstract (Both in Malay language and English)	200-250 words
Keywords	6-8 keywords
Introduction	500-1000 words
Literature Review (Alternatively: Background, conceptual	1000-2000 words
development or conceptual framework)	
Methods (Alternatively: Methodology)	500-1000 words
Results (Alternatively: Findings)	1000-1500 words
Discussion (Summary, Implications, Limitations,	1000-1500 words
Recommendations for future research)	
Conclusions	300 words
Total words	6000-8000 words



- **1. Authorship and Originality** to ensure that the manuscript is original and based from actual research work performed by the student, these points need to be considered:
- Plagiarism is a serious concern and must be avoided by the author/student. The supervisor will check that the **similarity rate is less than 30% using Turnitin software** (the report will be attached for each submission by the supervisor). Similarity index beyond 30% will affect course grading of the student.

- To reduce similarity index, sentence structure need to be modified and rewritten, not copied entirety from the source.
- All source of data/work need to be properly cited and provide the reference to avoid plagiarism issue.
- Authorship and the order of authorship must be agreed upon by all of the authors (main supervisor or cosupervisors) and any other personnel who participated in the work but are not included as an author.

- 2. Master in Economics & Master in Islamic Economics students are required to present and publish one (1) article in conference proceeding for grading purposes EPPE6908 only. For EPPE6906 the writing of manuscript is ready to be published & progress presentation in FEP Colloquium.
- 3. Article can be written in Malay or English language (based on supervisor consent).
- 4. The writing format is as follows:EPPE6908 & EPPE6906 Academic Paper (Economics & Islamic Economics) use the format of *Jurnal Ekonomi Malaysia* (JEM)

- 5. For the selection of supervisor, student is required to fill up a form to provide the research topic (proposal), and the name of potential supervisor. The supervisor will be determined by the faculty based on student's suggestion, the expertise of the supervisor to the topic and the supervision workload of the supervisor. The form can be collected at the Graduate office, FEP or downloaded from FEP website.
- 6. Completed academic paper should be submitted in CD form to FEP Postgraduate Office.

Discussion of Research Results	Discuss findings and correlate the findings with the
	literature and related theory.
Conclusion	Conclude the study, discuss the strengths and
	limitations of the study, if any, and propose ideas on
	relevant research.
