The validity period for the eVAL and Travel Authorisation approvals are 6 months from the date of issuance



 Student from countries that requires Single-Entry Visa (SEV) to enter Malaysia are required to submit their SEV application to the nearest Malaysian Mission office

❖ Students are required to undergo the RT-PCR COVID-19 Test within 72 hours before travelling to Malaysia. The RT-PCR COVID-19 test result must be translated in ENGLISH

❖ Students to complete the online payment for the quarantine and the COVID-19 Screening Test through MyEG. The collection of operational fixed charges (RM2,600) was abolished

 Students who are fully vaccinated can apply for Home Quarantine through MOH portal

Students are required to download the MySejahtera app and complete all the required information three (3) days prior to the arrival date



Student travel to Malaysia

(SEV) to enter Malaysia are required to undergo required to submit their SEV the RT-PCR COVID-19 Test at application to the nearest entry point

 Students who are fully vaccinated are subjected to mandatory quarantine for 7 days

During quarantine period, the RT-PCR COVID-19 Test will be conducted on the 5th day of the quarantine

Student will be issued with a Release Order upon the completion of the quarantine period

Education institutions will be required to receive the students from their respective quarantine station



 Student must complete a post arrival medical screening at EMGS /Universities registered clinics

Once the student passes the medical screening, the application can proceed to Immigration for the Student Pass endorsement



Immigration Dept endorse the Student Pass on the student passport

The Ikad, identity card will be issued upon issuance of student pass

The validity period for Travel **Authorisation** approval is 3 months from the date of issuance

ENTRANCE PROCEDURES TO MALAYSIA FOR THE DEPENDENT

CATEGORY	ACTION / CONDITIONS
1. Existing Dependant Pass holdersa) Dependant Pass holder that is still valid	❖ Not required to apply for MyTravel Pass and can enter Malaysia
b) Dependant Pass holder that has expired	 Required to apply for the MyTravel Pass via the Malaysian Immigration Department website. To apply for the Single-Entry Visa (SEV) if it is required to enter Malaysia.
2. New Dependants	 To ensure that the passport is valid for more than 18 months. The principal must have received their student pass. Required to apply for the MyTravel Pass via the Malaysian Immigration Department website To apply for the Single-Entry Visa (SEV) if it is required to enter Malaysia

- Kindly note that the entry procedures for international students (inclusive of their dependants) is subject to the guidelines from the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA)
- This directive is also subjected to the rules and guidelines by the enforcement agencies which are set by the Government of Malaysia
- International Students that are studying in Sabah and Sarawak are required to obtain approval from authorities in those states.
