- Bachelor's Degree in related field (i.e: Dietetics, Nutritional Science/ Nutrition, Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Biomedical Science, Food Technology, Food Service management or other suitable science subject) with CGPA ≥ 2.75 from and institutions of higher learning recognized by the senate;
- Those with CGPA of <2.75 to ≥ 2.5 with 5 years of work experience in the field listed above are also eligible to apply
- English Requirements (for international applicants): IELTS ≥ 5.5 , TOEFL iBT ≥ 46 , TOEFL Essentials: 8-9, any other English competency that has been approved by senate which is based on CFER
