

1. Admission & Application

- **Qualification (Local and International)**

- a. A Bachelor of Law (Honors) degree or A Bachelor of Syariah (Honors) degree AND Master of Laws degree or Syariah from any institution of higher learning recognized by the UKM Senate: or
- b. A Bachelor of Law (Honors) degree and Master degree from UKM or any institution of higher learning recognized by the UKM Senate; or
- c. International Candidate is required to fulfil the English language proficiency requirement as follows 600 (TOEFL) OR 100 TOEFL (Online) OR score 6.0 (IELTS) OR Malaysian University English Test (MUET) with minimum score Band 4 OR any exam that has been aligned to The Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) set by the respective program and approved by the Senate
- d. International candidates who do not meet the English language competency requirements may be given a Conditional Offer as follows:
 - i. Candidates are allowed to attend the internal Progressive English Program (PEP) at UKM, but students are still subject to the regulations of the Malaysian Immigration Department which are in force; AND
 - ii. International candidates who follow the internal Progressive English Program (PEP) need to sit for the MUET exam or any exam that has been aligned to The Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) to meet the English language competency requirements;
- e. Candidates are required to submit research proposal papers during application.
- f. Malay Language Requirements

International students must take the Malay language course as an Audit (U) course to be eligible to be awarded a degree as determined by the University
