

The next analysis in table 7 is the analysis of the personality trait level of the fourth personality is neuroticism (worried) is also measured to determine whether the users of the mosque toilet have this feature. The majority of respondents (74.8%) reported that they chose to disagree with this personality. The moderate percentage (24%) also reported neutral and 1.1% agreed.
