



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS NATURE EDUCATION FOREST (HPA)

1.	Always maintain the cleanliness and natural beauty of the Nature Education Forest area to preserve its environment for future visitors.
2.	When using fire, it must be closely supervised to prevent any risk of fire outbreaks or other forms of damage to the Nature Education Forest area.
3.	Activities such as jungle trekking and camping require prior permission from the Management to ensure they are conducted safely and responsibly.

5.	Entering or conducting activities in the palm oil plantation area is strictly forbidden to prevent unauthorized disturbances.
6.	All trash must be properly disposed of and removed from the Nature Education Forest to keep the area clean and safe for wildlife.
7.	Please ensure that electricity and water are turned off when not in use to support conservation efforts and avoid unnecessary waste.
8.	Ensure that all equipment and food are securely stored to avoid attracting animals and to minimize any negative impact on the forest's wildlife.
