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The architectural design of Masjid Wilayah Persekutuan. Masjid Wilayah Persekutuan or the Federal Territory Mosque is a major mosque and attraction in Kuala Lumpur. This magnificent building which is located in Jalan Duta is one of the most beautiful mosques in the country. It was constructed from 15 March 1996 to 30 August 2000 and opened to public on 25 October 2000. The mosque which was officiated by the 12th Yang diPertuan Agong, Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin ibn Almarhum Syed Putra Jamalulail on 18 February 2005 can accommodate 17,000 worshipers at any one time. The mosque's design is a blend of Ottoman, Middle Eastern and Malay architectural styles, heavily influenced by Sultan Ahmed Mosque or simply known as the Blue Mosque in Istanbul.
