The whole piece of Batu Bersurat Terengganu (Inscribed Stone of Terengganu). The Inscription Stone which is dated on Friday of Rajab 702H/1303AD was found after a big flood in 1887 on the bank of Tara river at Kampung Buloh, Kuala Berang, Hulu Terengganu and later had been used by the villagers who unaware of its historical significance as a platform for feet washing prior to entering Tok Abdul Rashid mosque and remained for fifteen years until a trader named Sayyid Husayn bin Ghulam al-Bukhari rediscovered and presented it to His Royal Highness the Sultan of Terengganu, Sultan Zainal Abidin III. In 1922, the deputy British Advisor in Terengganu, Major H.S. Peterson who failed to read the Inscription, requested a Japanese photographer, N. Suzuki to take picture of the Stone to be sent to Charles Otto Blagden at School of Oriental and African Studies, London University for deciphering purposes. In 1923, it was loaned to the Raffles Museum of Singapore and then moved to Kuala Lumpur upon completion of the National Museum. On 12 February 1987, the Terengganu Government requested for the return of the Stone. The Federal Government of Malaysia consented and on 6 July 1991, a ceremony marking its return was held at Wisma Darul Iman, Terengganu.
