The formation of Faculty of Islamic Studies traces its history back to 1955 with the inception of the Muslim College of Malaya, the first ever higher institution of Islamic Studies in the country. The long struggle to upgrade its status to a full university later been compromised with another counterpart of Malay language movement which also demands for the establishment of the first university to use Malay as language of instruction. The fight for the same cause resulted with the creation of the National University of Malaysia on 18th of May 1970 with the dissolved Muslim College of Malaya been integrated as the Faculty of Islamic Studies

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
