### **Executive summary**

This project has received funds from the European Union's Erasmus+ program (Grant agreement No: 2019-1-DE01-KA107-004838). The two partners are Frankfurt University of Applied Sciences and The National University of Malaysia (UKM). Both universities offer a similar range of programs from engineering & build environment to information technologies, economics and management, social science and health, with a strong focus on employability. Both institutions also embrace an explicit internationalisation policy. Consequently, they share a number of features in internationalization: Both encourage inbound and outbound mobility, provide international and transnational academic programs, create subject-related international research networks, as well as have strong ties with private companies and organisations who operate transnationally. This project has three priority areas: (1) Support new area studies at the Centre for Occidental Studies (IKMAS/UKM); (2) Cooperate in methodology training and applied social research; and (3) Carry out joint projects in the area of regional aviation integration programs between IKMAS and Frankfurt UAS. Funding for the project provides for short-term-mobility, study semesters, and research fellowships for both students and academic staff in the following course-packages: Transnational Social Work, International Business Administration and International Finance.
