Associate Professor Helen Ting (PhD in Political Science, Sciences Po, Paris) is a Senior Research Fellow at the Institute of Malaysian and International Studies (IKMAS), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM). She was an Erasmus Mundus post-doctoral scholar at Humboldt University, Berlin (2012-2013), member of the International Pluralism Advisory Group (2014-2017) of the Global Centre for Pluralism, Ottawa and non-resident Distinguished Research Fellow at the Institute of Malaysia Studies of Xiamen University (2019-2022). She has published widely on subjects related to the politics of national identity, national integration, gender politics, inter-religious and interethnic relations, and electoral politics. Her most recent publications are two co-edited books, *Electoral Reform and Democracy in Malaysia* (NIAS Press) and *Negotiating Ethnic Diversity and National Identity in History Education – International and Comparative Perspectives* (Palgrave Macmillan).
