- A Bachelor degree with First Class Honours or equivalent with Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of not less than 3.67 from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia or other universities recognized by the university Senate; OR
- 5. International students must have proficiency in spoken and written English with IELTS ≥ Band 6.5 or MUET ≥ Band 4 or TOEFL iBT ≥ 79 or TOEFL pBT ≥ 548 or Pearson Test of English ≥ 63 or Cambridge English Qualifications and Test ≥ 176 OR any equivalent qualifications, taken within the last two years prior to application; AND
- All international and self-financed applicants must produce an accepted written proof of financial status either in a form of an active bank/financial institution statement or accepted letter of guarantee.

> Programme Structure

All students are required to complete the 'Research Methodology' course in the beginning of the study.  - Present their research findings in at least one (local or international) conference
