

Poster Guidelines

The notes below cover what we need from poster presenters. A PowerPoint template is provided, and the simplest approach is to build your poster directly on it.

Size and printing

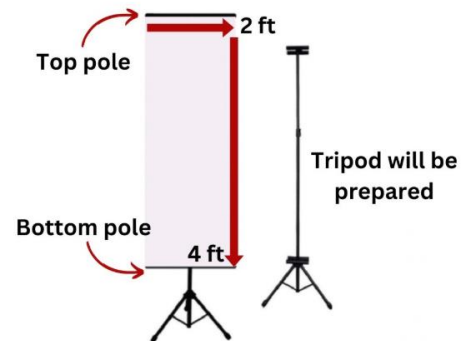
Print your poster as a portrait bunting banner, 2 feet wide by 4 feet high (24 × 48 inches), with a pole at the top and bottom so it can hang from a stand. Please have it printed before you arrive, as printing cannot be arranged at the venue. We will provide a tripod stand at your spot to display the banner.

*Please note that the tripod belongs to the organiser and must be returned after use.

What to include

Read the poster from top to bottom. In order, it should carry:

- **Title**, with authors and their affiliations (mark the presenter)
- **A short introduction** stating the problem and why it matters
- **Objectives**
- **Materials and methods**, preferably shown as a simple diagram
- **Results** as tables or figures, each with a short caption
- **Discussion** (which may be combined with results)
- **Conclusion**
- **References, acknowledgements, and your contact details**
- **Institution/sponsor logos** along the bottom



Making it readable

A poster is read from a metre or two away, so keep the type large.

Presenting

Your abstract will already have been accepted, and there is no poster file to submit; simply bring your printed banner on the day. Two judges will come round during the session to evaluate each poster, so stay with yours to present your work and answer their questions.
