




Word Origin & History risk 1661, risque, from Fr. risque, from It.

risco, riscio (modern rischio), from riscare "run into danger," of uncertain origin. The Anglicized spelling first recorded 1728. Sp. riesgo and Ger. Risiko are It. loanwords. The verb is from 1687; risky first recorded 1826.



At the **risk** of overturning the machine he veered it sharply to the left.


