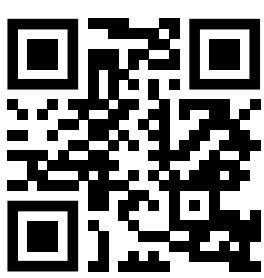

Institut Kajian Etnik (KITA) telah ditubuhkan secara rasmi oleh Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia pada 8 Oktober 2007, bersamaan tarikh pelantikan Prof. Ulung Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin sebagai Pengarah Pengasasnya.

KITA merupakan satu-satunya institut penyelidikan di Malaysia yang sepenuhnya memfokuskan kajian terhadap etnik dan etnisiti. Walaupun orientasi akademiknya bersifat kajian tematik, namun KITA didukung kuat oleh orientasi kajian disiplin dan kajian wilayah, justeru itu KITA menggalakkan kajian silang-disiplin yang melibatkan tiga sektor utama masyarakat iaitu, sektor awam, sektor swasta dan sektor komuniti. Ini bermakna, KITA melaksanakan kegiatannya dengan menggunakan pendekatan inklusivist.

Umum mengetahui bahawa, secara global, kajian etnik kebanyakannya muncul daripada keadaan atau situasi sosial yang traumatik, malah bergelora dengan keganasan. Namun di Malaysia, persoalan yang sering ditanyakan ialah “bagaimana ia mampu mengekalkan hubungan antara etnik yang secara relatifnya lebih stabil dan harmoni?”. Usaha pencarian jawapan-jawapan ilmiah kepada soalan-soalan sebegini menjadi motivasi kepada penubuhan KITA.

Dalam tahun-tahun kebelakangan ini, apa yang lebih penting ialah berlakunya peningkatan globalisasi dan pergerakan tenaga buruh transnasional dalam skala besar yang menyumbang kepada peningkatan kemajmukan etnik dalam masyarakat di seluruh dunia, seterusnya mengakibatkan timbulnya cabaran konseptual-teoretikal dalam memahami fenomena sosial baharu di peringkat analisis akademik mahupun advokasi sosial dan polisi.

Dalam ucapan Belanjawan 2018 oleh YAB Dato’ Sri Mohd Najib Tun Haji Abdul Razak, Perdana Menteri dan Menteri Kewangan di Dewan Rakyat pada hari Jumaat, 27 Oktober 2017, Institut Kajian Etnik (KITA-UKM) telah diumumkan penaiktarafannya kepada sebuah institut kebangsaan di bawah Pe-Tunjang Kelapan: Mengimbangi Par Excellence Duniawi dan Par Excellence Ukhrawi.

The Institute of Ethnic Studies (KITA) was officially established on the 8th of October 2007, on the date when Prof. Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin, was appointed by the Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) as the Director of KITA.

KITA is the only full-fledged research institute in Malaysia focusing specifically on ‘ethnic studies.’ Although academically, KITA has a ‘thematic studies’ orientation, it, however, draws its strength from both ‘disciplinary studies’ as well as ‘area studies,’ thus encouraging cross-disciplinary activities, involving three major sectors of the society, namely, the public, the private, and the community sectors. Thus KITA adopts an inclusivist approach in conducting its activities.

It is well-known that, globally, ethnic studies have emerged mostly from traumatic and even turbulent, violent circumstances. However, in Malaysia’s case, the frequently asked question is “how is it that she has been able to sustain, comparatively and relatively, stable and harmonious inter-ethnic relations?”. The pursuit of some credible answers for such questions motivates the establishment of KITA.

But more importantly, in recent years, increased globalization and large-scale transnational labour movement, has resulted in increased ethnic pluralization of societies worldwide, which, consequently, presents a new set of sociological complexities hence theoretic-conceptual challenges to comprehend this new phenomenon, both at the level of academic analyses as well as public advocacy and policies.

In 2018 Budget speech by YAB Dato’ Sri Mohd Najib Tun Haji Abdul Razak, Prime Minister and Minister of Finance in Dewan Rakyat on Friday, 27 October 2017, it was announced that Institute of Ethnic Studies (KITA-UKM) will be elevated to a national institute under the Eighth Thrust: Balancing between the Par Excellence of Worldly and Hereafter.

Pada 22 Februari 2019 KITA-UKM telah dianugerahkan dengan Kursi UNESCO dalam bidang Praktis Sosial dalam Komunikasi Antara Budaya dan Kesepaduan Sosial dengan Pengarah Pengasas KITA Prof. Ulung Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin sebagai Penyandang Kursi. On February 22nd, 2019, KITA-UKM was awarded a UNESCO Chair on Social Practices in Intercultural Communication and Social Cohesion with KITA Founding Director Distinguished Prof. Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin as the Chairholder. This is the very first UNESCO Chair to be awarded to UKM and the first in Malaysia within the field of intercultural communication, focusing on ethnic studies and social cohesion. The UNESCO Chair has been renewed for an additional four years from 2023 to 2027 by the UNESCO Headquarters with KITA Founding Director Distinguished Prof. Datuk Dr. Shamsul Amri Baharuddin as the Chairholder and KITA Principal Research Fellow Dr. Eric Olmedo-Panal as the Co-Chairholder.

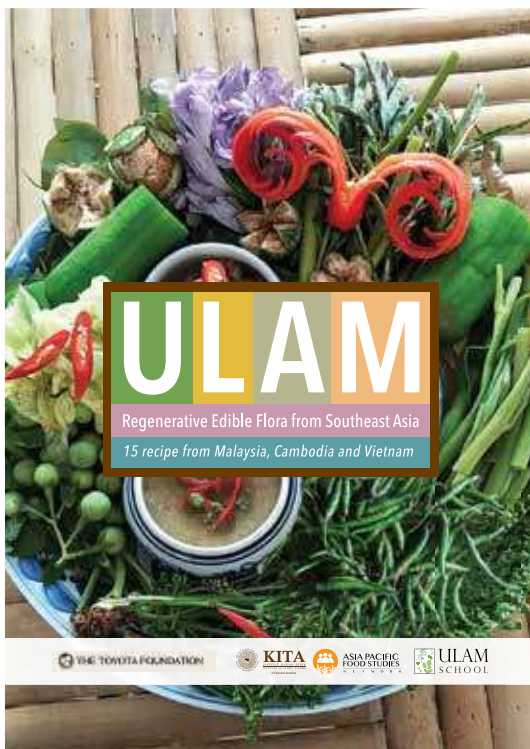

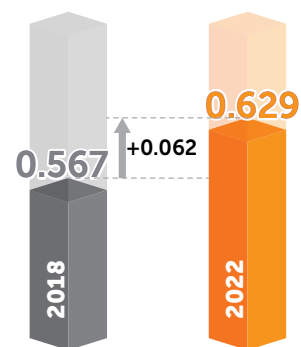

Kajian Indeks Perpaduan Nasional (IPNas) merupakan inisiatif penting kerajaan Malaysia untuk mengukur tahap perpaduan dan keharmonian negara ini secara komprehensif. Untuk itu, pasukan penyelidik dari KITA melalui UKM Pakarunding Sdn Bhd telah diberi peranan mereka bentuk dan melaksanakan Kajian Indeks Perpaduan Nasional fasa kedua (IPNas 2.0) pada 2022. IPNas 2022 adalah kesinambungan daripada IPNas fasa pertama yang telah dibangun dan dilaksanakan oleh agensi dan pasukan penyelidik yang sama pada tahun 2018 (IPNas 1.0).

Kutipan data kajian IPNas 2.0 telah dijalankan pasca pandemik COVID-19 iaitu dari 5 Januari hingga 24 Februari 2022 meliputi 13 negeri di Malaysia dan tiga Wilayah Persekutuan. Sebanyak 28,613 responden kajian telah diperoleh dan diguna dalam analisis.

IPNas 2.0 mencatat skor 0.629 pada skala tahap perpaduan di antara 0.0 hingga 1.0. Skala ini dibahagikan kepada empat kategori iaitu tahap perpaduan lemah (0.0-0.24), tahap perpaduan rendah (0.25-0.49), tahap perpaduan sederhana (0.50-0.74) dan tahap perpaduan tinggi (0.75-1.0). Dengan skor 0.629, IPNas 2.0 menunjukkan peningkatan sebanyak 0.062 berbanding nilai IPNas 1.0 iaitu 0.567. Dapatan ini menunjukkan bahawa tahap perpaduan dalam kalangan rakyat Malaysia adalah sederhana dan terkawal walaupun telah melalui kehidupan mencabar semasa pandemik COVID-19.

Kajian IPNas fasa ketiga (IPNas 3.0) akan diteruskan oleh Kementerian Perpaduan Negara bersama KITA bermula pada tahun 2024.

The National Unity Index Study (IPNas) is a significant initiative by the Malaysian government to comprehensively measure the level of unity and harmony in the country. In this regard, a research team from KITA, through UKM Pakarunding Sdn Bhd, was tasked with designing and implementing the National Unity Index Study Second Phase (IPNas 2.0) in 2022. This study is a continuation of the first phase of IPNas, developed and conducted by the same agency and research team in 2018 (IPNas 1.0).

Data collection for IPNas 2.0 was conducted in the post-COVID-19 pandemic period, from January 5 to February 24, 2022, covering 13 states in Malaysia and three Federal Territories. A total of 28,613 respondents were surveyed, and the data were used for analysis.

IPNas 2.0 recorded a score of 0.629 on a scale level of unity from 0.0 to 1.0. This scale is divided into four categories namely, weak (0.0-0.24), low (0.25-0.49), moderate (0.50-0.74), and high (0.75-1.0). With a score of 0.629, IPNas 2.0 shows an increase of 0.062 compared to the IPNas 1.0 value of 0.567. These findings indicate that the level of unity among Malaysians is good and under control despite experiencing a challenging life during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The third phase of IPNas (IPNas 3.0) will be continued by the Ministry of National Unity together with KITA in the year 2024.

GMSN was strategically re-based at KITA (GMSN@KITA) in 2021 and launched in 2022 with KITA Research Fellow Dr. Ramze Endut as the Coordinator in February 2023.

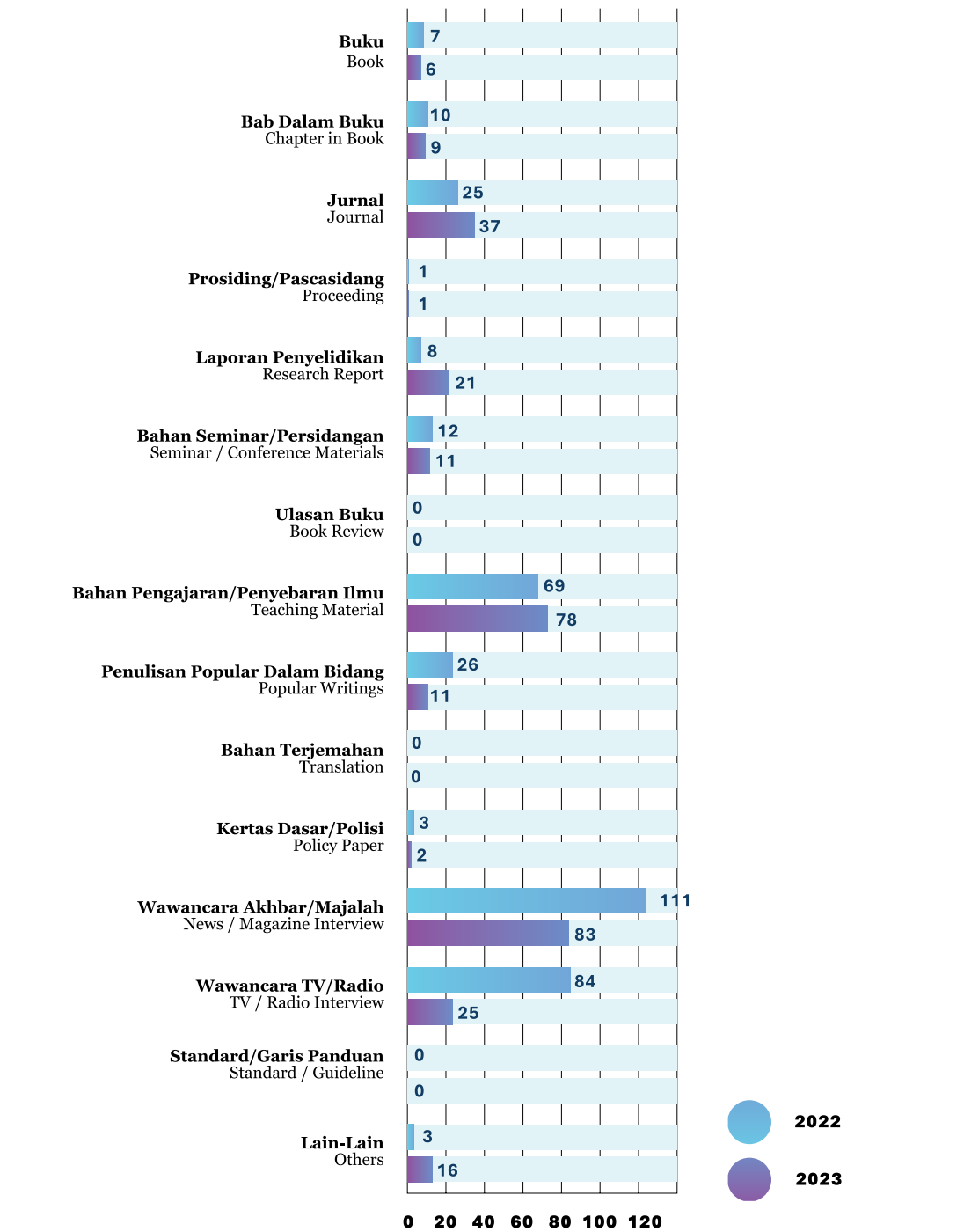

Manufacturing-Related Services (MRS): Definition, Contribution, Issues & Challenges

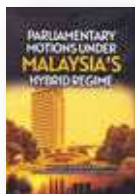

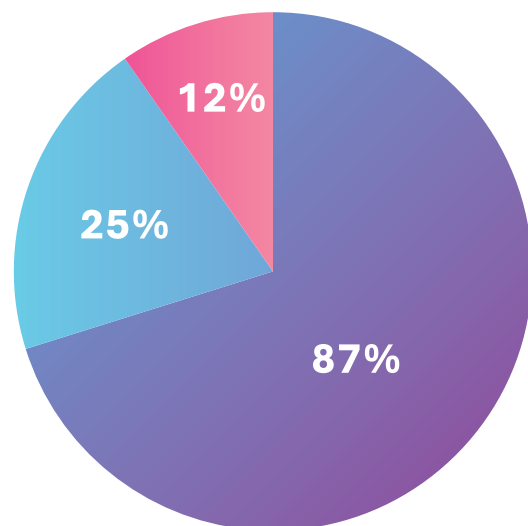
