Admission Process

Nominated Student

Screening and selection will be done by respective universities. UKM will consider your application after nominations are done by the respective universities.

Visa Requirement

It is compulsory for all students to apply for the 'Visa With Reference' (VDR) after receiving the Letter of Offer from UKM. The VDR needs to be submitted to the Malaysian Embassy in home countries.

Credit Transfer

All units offered at UKM will be eligible for credit transfer at your home universities. Please confirm with your respective faculties on details of courses and syllabus.
