<b>Dinner</b>	<b>: 6.00pm - 7.00pm</b>

For non-operating college cafeterias, food preparation will be handled by the nearby cafeteria. The cafeteria will then send to the relevant colleges. Food will be provided in packed form to avoid gathering of students in the college cafeteria. In this regard, students are advised to have their meals in their respective rooms.
