



MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER FOR THE COVID 19 TRANSMISSION CONTROL EFFECTIVE FROM 18 TO 31 MARCH 2020

Concerning the **Movement Control Order** based on the **Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988** and the **Police Act 1967** issued by the **Malaysian Government** on **March 16, 2020**, The University hereby reminds all students of the main restrictions that must be met during the enforcement period.

All students including the international students who are still on campus, rentals or other personal residences **MUST STAY** at their current premises (including students who have purchased tickets). Students are **NOT** allowed to return to their hometown as long as the **Movement Control Order** is in force. Students must report to the University Management and subject to the authority's order. The University will be responsible for all the basic, safety and welfare needs of the students throughout the period of enforcement.

Any violation of the **MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER** may be subject to detention under the **Act 574 of the Penal Code** by the authorities. The University shall not be liable for any action taken by the authorities for breach of the order.
