## Guideline on Masters Clinical Research Conducted in Ministry of Health, Malaysia Facilities

- All Masters Clinical Research conducted in Ministry of Health, Malaysia Facilities must be registered in NMRR and obtain Medical Research Ethics Committee (MREC) approval prior to conducting the study
- Please ensure that the research proposal is submitted to UKM MREC and NMRR <https://nmrr.gov.my/> for approval **at least 4-6 months prior to study data collection**.

### 1. Role of Supervisors

- a. Guide students to ensure protocol is standardized according to MREC requirements, in addition to UKM REC requirements (Please refer to CRC of Ministry of Health, Malaysia Hospital where research is to be conducted)
- b. Ensure students acquire MREC approval prior to conducting research

### 2. Responsibility of Ministry of Health, Malaysia Supervisor

- a. Facilitate study in Ministry of Health, Malaysia hospital through hospital CRC
- b. Facilitate the preparation of **all relevant documents** required for NMRR submission, pertaining to the role of Ministry of Health, Malaysia facility and supervisor
- c. Ensure students acquire MREC approval prior to conducting research
- d. Ensure study follows protocol that has been approved by MREC

### 3. Role of Masters Student

- a. Ensure that study obtains approval from UKM REC
- b. Ensure that study is registered in NMRR as student project
- c. Ensure that all documents required for NMRR is submitted accordingly
- d. Ensure that study obtains MREC approval prior to conducting study in MINISTRY OF HEALTH, MALAYSIA hospital or facility
- e. Ensure all ethical principles are adhered to when conducting study
- f. Ensure study is conducted according to approved protocol
