HEET TRAINING PROGRAMME

Purpose	To enhance students' English language proficiency across all four skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
Aim	To equip students for success in the Higher Education English Test (HEET) .
Objective	The programme is tailored to equip prospective students with the following abilities: a) Familiarity with relevant texts and audio materials commonly encountered in higher education. b) Effective expression of views through descriptive and argumentative essays on higher education topics. c) Clear and confident presentation and argumentation on general higher education issues.
Curriculum Design	Key Focus: A strong emphasis on speaking and writing skills.
HEET Training Programme	 Participants in the HEET Training Programme are those who may have: a) Insufficient English proficiency for programme entry. b) No recognised English proficiency test results submitted. c) Met minimum English proficiency requirements and may require further English language training. The Programme is designed to prepare students for HEET. Students are strongly encouraged to join in the training programme before registering for HEET. A Placement Test will determine the students' level in the HEET training programme. Notwithstanding, high-achieving students may be permitted to take HEET prior to completing all levels of training. For example, a student may be initially placed at a lower level based on the placement test. However, consistent excellent performance during training may qualify them for HEET. Students who do not successfully advance to the next level will repeat the current level.
HEET (Test)	HEET is conducted on the last Saturday of every month.
