

## HEET TRAINING PROGRAMME

<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To enhance students' English language proficiency across all four skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.</li> </ul>
<b>Aim</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To equip students for success in the <b>Higher Education English Test (HEET)</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>Objective</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The programme is tailored to equip prospective students with the following abilities:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Familiarity with relevant texts and audio materials commonly encountered in higher education.</li> <li>b) Effective expression of views through descriptive and argumentative essays on higher education topics.</li> <li>c) Clear and confident presentation and argumentation on general higher education issues.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Curriculum Design</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Key Focus: A strong emphasis on speaking and writing skills.</li> </ul>
<b>HEET Training Programme</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants in the HEET Training Programme are those who may have:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Insufficient English proficiency for programme entry.</li> <li>b) No recognised English proficiency test results submitted.</li> <li>c) Met minimum English proficiency requirements and may require further English language training.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• The Programme is designed to prepare students for HEET.</li> <li>• Students are strongly encouraged to join in the training programme before registering for HEET.</li> <li>• A Placement Test will determine the students' level in the HEET training programme.</li> <li>• Notwithstanding, high-achieving students may be permitted to take HEET prior to completing all levels of training.</li> <li>• For example, a student may be initially placed at a lower level based on the placement test. However, consistent excellent performance during training may qualify them for HEET.</li> <li>• Students who do not successfully advance to the next level will repeat the current level.</li> </ul>
<b>HEET (Test)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HEET is conducted on the last Saturday of every month.</li> </ul>
