- 1. All abstracts must be submitted by 20th April 2017.
- 2. All abstracts are to be written in English.
- 3. The abstract must not contain more than 300 words in a single paragraph.
- 4. The author' last names, initials, their institutions, city and country should be listed immediately beneath the abstract title, typed in upper and lower case and single-spaced.
- 5. The abstract should be typeset in upper and lower case and single-spaced. The format of writing out the: Aims, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion is greatly recommended.
- 6. No abstract that has been presented orally or as a poster at a previous national or international meeting of this any society will be considered for presentation at this meeting.
- 7. Abstract must be submitted either in the form of a Microsoft Word file (document file) using Arial font or using the attached Abstract form.
- 8. Abstract saved in the form of picture or clip files such as Bitmap, JPEG or TIFF will not be accepted.
- Abstract must be saved and send directly to the Congress Secretariat using a floppy disc or CD, or alternatively it can also be send via email to <a href="mailto:umbi.nts2017@gmail.com">umbi.nts2017@gmail.com</a>
- 10. If using the form, it must be submitted without corrections, smudges, errors and misspellings.
  - Photocopies of the forms may be reproduced for use.
  - The entire abstract including the title, author/s, location and text must fit within the frame of the form and leaving a clear margin at all the four sides of the frame.
  - Abstracts must be submitted in Arial font in at least 11-point type.
  - Authors should include a short precise title in capital letters within the top box, clearly defining the topic of the abstract.
  - Simple tables of graphs (neat and in black) may be included if they fit within the form.
  - Abstract will appear exactly as submitted. Abstract with smudges, errors, misspelling, incorrect hyphenation, faint typing, etc. (or not confronting to the prescribed rules) will require typing at the author's expense.

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
